

## **Job Title - FSRH Northern Ireland Committee Chair**

### **Overview**

The Faculty of Sexual and Reproductive Healthcare (FSRH) is the professional home of doctors, nurses and other healthcare professionals who work in sexual and reproductive healthcare in the UK. FSRH Northern Ireland Committee is a regional committee that supports the work of the FSRH in Northern Ireland. The Chair of the FSRH Northern Ireland Committee will lead the committee and work with members to ensure that the needs of sexual and reproductive healthcare professionals in Northern Ireland are met.

### **Responsibilities:**

- Attend the FSRH Council and write quarterly updates with the support of the secretary.
- Provide leadership to the FSRH Northern Ireland Committee, including chairing meetings and overseeing committee work.
- Work with committee members to develop and deliver a programme of events and activities that meet the needs of sexual and reproductive healthcare professionals in Northern Ireland.
- Represent the FSRH Northern Ireland Committee and the FSRH at external meetings and events Government-led meetings.
- Develop and maintain relationships with key stakeholders, including healthcare professionals, policy makers and other organisations working in sexual and reproductive healthcare in Northern Ireland.
- Work with the FSRH and other FSRH committees to ensure that the needs of sexual and reproductive healthcare professionals in Northern Ireland are represented at a national level.
- Work with the FSRH Northern Ireland Committee administrative support to ensure that the committee is managed effectively and efficiently.

### **Qualifications:**

- Must be a member of the FSRH in good standing (all member grades are eligible)
- Experience and active involvement in sexual and reproductive healthcare.
- Experience in leadership and management of committees or teams.
- Strong interpersonal and communication skills.
- Strong understanding of best practice in EDI, as it is practice in governance
- Ability to work collaboratively with others.

This is a voluntary position, but reasonable expenses will be reimbursed. The Chair of the FSRH Northern Ireland Committee will be expected to commit approximately 2-3 days per month to the role.
