	The WDSC is a committee of the FSRH. Its role is to contribute to the development of SRH multidisciplinary workforce and to make sure it meets patient needs.
Role overview	The FSRH are calling for a senior SRH Specialist Nurse to represent the FSRH and help lead an exciting project to pilot the development and introduction of a new 'credential' for ACPs working in integrated sexual health and HIV services.
	The FSRH, the British Association for Sexual Health and HIV (BASHH) and the National HIV Nurses Association (NHIVA) have collaborated on a training curriculum that has been supported by HEE and endorsed by RCN and BHIVA.
	This Joint Curriculum and Credentialling Committee are now keen to progress our work to develop a clear assessment framework and to pilot the introduction of a sustainable credentialling programme.
Terms of role	This phase of the project is due to be start in the second part of 2021 and will continue through 2022.
	This role will require the attendance of monthly remote meetings alongside working on additional outputs and activities in between



	meetings. It is anticipated much of the work will be achieved virtually.
	The role also requires attendance of at least two WDSC meetings per year, and working with others in the committee to ensure the development and delivery of the work plan.
